What is discrimination?

Discrimination is when someone treats you differently, unfairly or worse because of a characteristic that you have such as your age or your race.

The Equality Act 2010

The Equality Act is a law made by the Government which protects people from discrimination. It means that discrimination or unfair treatment because you have a certain characteristic such as your age or your race, is against the law (illegal).


What does *Characteristic* mean?

Characteristics are features of something or someone. Characteristics make a person or a thing different from others. For example, the ability to camouflage is a characteristic of the chameleon. Understanding the characteristics of someone or something helps us to identify them.

Age




Our age means how old we are; how many years we have lived. People's ages can be called:

Some people follow a religion; some people do not follow a religion.










Race


Pregnancy and Maternity


Sex or Gender




The sex or gender of a person means whether they are male or female.










Sex (Gender)

Gender Reassignment






Some people feel that the gender they are born with does not match how they feel as they grow up.

There are many different kinds of families. For example:


In some families there are 2 mums or 2 dads or a mum and a dad. Some families have just a dad, some families have just a mum. There are also other kinds of
