She was born 6th July 1907, in Coyoacán, Mexico City, Mexico and died 13.7.54. <u>SELF PORTRAITS BY KHALO</u> Know portrait is when an artist creates a painting/drawing of someone else. A self portrait is when an artist
		 draws/paints themselves. CULTURAL BACKGROUND Understand that key characteristics of Mexican folk art are brightly coloured paintings and jewellery featuring lots of flora and fauna. Vibrantly coloured plants, lush forests snd different creatures feature heavily. SURREALISM Understand that the surrealist movement developed in Europe in the aftermaths of WW1.
